

#### Horizontal issues and challenges



- Aim of the study: analyse the feasibility of ED/EL measures for mobile phones&tablets
- Strong relevance of material efficiency aspects
   linked to this, dedicated approaches under the MEErP
- Quantitative methods and standards for the assessment



#### **Task 7 – options under analysis**

- Option 1: "No action" (i.e. bau)
- Option 2: Self-regulation
- Option 3: Ecodesign requirements
- Option 4: Energy Labelling (on battery endurance)
- Option 5: Ecodesign + Energy Labelling.



#### **Parallel initiatives**

- Non regulatory:
  - Ecorating scheme (telephonic operators)
  - *iFixit scheme? standards?*
- Regulatory: French repair index
